Name	Description	Total value
<b>ATCO Australia Undergraduate Scholarship</b>	Available to undergraduate students demonstrating academic achievement and financial hardship.	\$10,000
<b>BHP Billiton Regional and Remote Undergraduate Scholarship</b>	Available to commencing regional or remote students who are able to demonstrate outstanding academic achievement and community, cultural and/or sporting involvement.	\$53,000 over three years
<b>BHP Billiton Undergraduate Scholarship in the UWA Business School</b>	Available to commencing students who are able to demonstrate outstanding academic achievement and community, cultural and/or sporting involvement. Up to three scholarships available in 2017.	\$22,000 over three years
<b>David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Residential Scholarship</b>	Supports an Indigenous student studying full-time towards a Bachelor of Commerce and residing at a University college.	Up to \$20,000 towards residential college fees
<b>David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Commencing Scholarship</b>	Supports an Indigenous student commencing full-time study in the Bachelor of Commerce.	\$10,000
<b>James McClements Scholarship in the UWA Business School</b>	Available to commencing students from a rural, regional or remote area of Western Australia who demonstrate academic achievement and leadership potential. Preference is given to students from the Pilbara.	\$7500
<b>John Willinge Scholarship in the UWA Business School</b>	Available to commencing high achieving students who demonstrate leadership potential and who are experiencing financial hardship.	\$10,000 over three years
<b>John Willinge Regional and Remote Scholarship in the UWA Business School</b>	Available to commencing students from a rural, regional or remote area of Western Australia who demonstrate academic achievement and leadership potential.	\$10,000 over three years
<b>Sir Frank Ledger Scholarship in the UWA Business School</b>	Available to commencing high achieving students who demonstrate leadership potential and who are experiencing financial hardship.	\$10,000 over three years

## Undergraduate scholarships - current students

Name	Description	Total value
<b>ATCO Australia Undergraduate Scholarship</b>	Available to undergraduate students demonstrating academic achievement and financial hardship.	\$10,000
<b>BHP Billiton Women in Business and Engineering</b>	Available to female students completing one major in Engineering Science, and one major from the Bachelor of Commerce. Applicants must be enrolled in a Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Philosophy (Honours). Applicants should have completed at least 48 points towards their degree and be able to demonstrate outstanding achievements in community, leadership, cultural and/or sporting involvement. Up to four scholarships are available in 2017.	\$22,000 over two years
<b>David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Residential Scholarship</b>	Supports an Indigenous student studying full-time towards a Bachelor of Commerce and residing at a University college.	Up to \$20,000 towards residential college fees
<b>David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Continuing Scholarship</b>	Supports an Indigenous student studying full-time in the second or third year of a Bachelor of Commerce. Applicants must demonstrate leadership potential.	\$10,000
<b>Dr Merab Tauman Memorial Scholarship in Economics</b>	Supports high achieving students who have completed at least 96 points of an undergraduate degree with a major in economics.	\$10,000
<b>Perth Energy Scholarship</b>	Available to Australian and international students who have completed at least 48 points of a Bachelor of Commerce and who demonstrate academic excellence.	\$10,000

## Honours scholarships

Name	Description	Total value
<b>BHP Billiton Honours Scholarship</b>	Open to students demonstrating academic excellence and an interest in issues relevant to the mining and resources sector. Up to six scholarships are awarded annually, with two scholarships reserved for Indigenous students.	\$20,000
<b>C.A. Vargovic Memorial Scholarship</b>	For students undertaking honours in Economics and who have an interest in macroeconomics.	Value to be determined
<b>David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Residential Scholarship</b>	Supports an Indigenous student studying full-time towards a Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) and who is residing at a University college. Applicants must demonstrate leadership potential.	Up to \$20,000 towards residential college fees
<b>David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Continuing Scholarship</b>	Available to Indigenous students who are completing honours on a full-time basis. Applicants must demonstrate leadership potential.	\$10,000
<b>Jean Rogerson Honours Scholarship in the UWA Business School</b>	Awarded to an honours student on the basis of academic merit.	\$6000
<b>Stan and Jean Perron Honours Scholarship</b>	Available to students undertaking honours as part of the Bachelor of Commerce or Bachelor of Economics, and whose research examines business ethics and/or entrepreneurship. Up to two scholarships are available in 2017.	\$15,000
<b>Victor Raeburn Honours Scholarship</b>	Available to students who have demonstrated academic achievement and are completing a Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) or Bachelor of Economics (Honours) in an area relevant to the financial services industry.	\$10,000

## Postgraduate coursework scholarships

Name	Description	Total value
<b>BHP Billiton Accelerated MBA Trimester Scholarship</b>	Open to MBA Flexible students who wish to reduce their work commitments to study full-time for one trimester. Awarded based on academic achievement, although students must demonstrate an interest in the resources sector or broadly related industries and communities and a commitment to the MBA / Business School community. <b>BHP Billiton Masters Scholarship</b>	Available to MBA or other master's degrees by coursework students with an interest in the resources sector. Up to two scholarships are available in 2017.	\$40,000
<b>BHP Billiton Social Impact (Not-For-Profit) Scholarship</b>	Available to Graduate Certificate in Social Impact students who are currently employed in the not-for-profit sector. Up to \$9300 (partial unit fee waiver)
<b>C.A. Vargovic Memorial Scholarship</b>	Available to Master of Economics and PhD students intending to undertake research in the area of macroeconomics.	Value to be determined
<b>David Mack Indigenous Postgraduate Scholarship</b>	Supports an Indigenous student enrolled full-time in any master's by coursework degree at the UWA Business School, with preference given to MBA Full Time Intensive and MBA Flexible students. All MBA Full Time Intensive students are automatically considered and all other applicants must demonstrate leadership potential and an interest in business and commerce.	\$50,000
<b>Mining Leaders Scholarship</b>	Available to students undertaking the MBA Full Time Intensive or MBA Flexible on a full-time basis. Applicants must demonstrate strong academic achievement, an interest in resources and/or mining, and leadership skills or potential. Up to two scholarships available in 2017.	\$15,000
<b>MBA Full Time Intensive scholarships - various</b>	Every student who is accepted into the MBA Full Time Intensive will automatically be considered for a range of scholarships. For details, see <a href="http://mba.uwa.edu.au">mba.uwa.edu.au</a>	Various
