Scholarships for commencing Bachelor of Commerce students: 2017

The UWA Business School offers a range of scholarships for students enrolling in the first year of a Bachelor of Commerce.

The following scholarships are available to citizens and permanent residents of Australia.



ATCO Australia Undergraduate Scholarship

- For a student experiencing financial hardship
- Valued at \$10,000
- Selection criteria: Demonstrated financial hardship; academic achievement

BHP Billiton Regional and Remote Scholarship

- For a commencing student from a regional or remote background
- Valued at \$53,000 over three years
- Selection criteria: Academic achievement; demonstrated community, cultural and/or sporting involvement

BHP Billiton Undergraduate Scholarship

- Valued at \$22,000 over three years
- Up to three scholarships available
- Selection criteria: Academic achievement; demonstrated community, cultural and/or sporting involvement

David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Commencing Scholarship

- For an Indigenous student commencing full-time study
- Valued at \$10,000 over one year
- Selection criteria: Academic achievement

David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Residential Scholarship

- For an Indigenous student studying full-time and residing at a University college
- Valued at up to \$20,000 towards residential college fees
- Selection criteria: Academic achievement; interest in business and commerce



James McClements Scholarship

- For a commencing student from a regional or remote background
- Valued at \$7,500 over one year
- Preference will be given to students from the Pilbara
- Selection criteria: Academic achievement; leadership potential

John Willinge Scholarship in the UWA Business School

- For a commencing student experiencing financial hardship
- Valued at \$10,000 over three years
- Selection criteria: Academic achievement; leadership potential; financial hardship

John Willinge Regional and Remote Scholarship in the UWA Business School

- For a commencing student from a regional or remote background
- Valued at \$10,000 over three years
- Selection criteria: Academic achievement; leadership potential

Sir Frank Ledger Scholarship

- For a commencing student experiencing financial hardship
- Valued at \$10,000 over three years
- Selection criteria: Financial hardship; academic achievement; leadership potential
