David Mack Indigenous Scholarships in Business 2017

Indigenous students studying at the UWA Business School can apply for a range of scholarships.

David Mack Indigenous Residential Scholarship

Supports an Indigenous student studying full-time towards a Bachelor of Commerce or Bachelor of Commerce (Honours) and residing at a University college.

Value: Up to \$20,000 towards residential college fees (if college fees are less than \$20,000, the difference will be given as a cash payment)

Duration: One year

Note: All applicants must demonstrate academic achievement. Applicants who are in their second year or beyond of study will be required to demonstrate leadership potential.

David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Commencing Scholarship

Supports an Indigenous student commencing full-time study in the Bachelor of Commerce.

Value: \$10,000 cash payment

Duration: One year

Note: Applicants should demonstrate academic achievement and an interest in business and commerce studies.

David Mack Indigenous Undergraduate Continuing Scholarship

For an Indigenous student studying full-time in the second, third or honours year of a Bachelor of Commerce.

Value: \$10,000 cash payment

Duration: One year

Note: Applicants will be required to demonstrate leadership potential and academic achievement.

David Mack Indigenous Postgraduate Scholarship

Supports an Indigenous student enrolled full-time in any master's by coursework degree at the UWA Business School, with preference given to MBA Full Time Intensive and MBA Flexible students.

Value: \$50,000 cash payment

Duration: One year

Note: Applicants in a course other than the MBA Full Time Intensive will be required to demonstrate leadership potential and an interest in business

and commerce studies. MBA Full Time Intensive students will be assessed on their interview and GMAT score.

David Mack Indigenous Study Grants

Supports Indigenous students at the UWA Business School with expenses such as laptops, travel, student exchange, conference fees and internships.

Note: Up to four grants with a combined total value of \$4,000 will be awarded annually.
