Option 1: Student Exchange

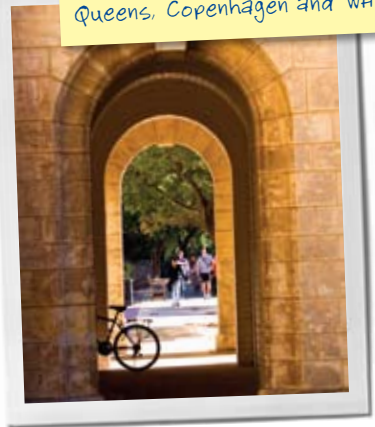
Option 2: Study Abroad

Undergraduate

The UWA Business School offers two undergraduate degrees, the Bachelor of Economics (BEc) and the Bachelor of Commerce (BCom), which include a number of majors across a wide range of disciplines. Both degrees from the School equip students with the skills required to take up careers in a variety of fields, depending on the area of specialisation. In addition, combined degrees are also available for students pursuing a degree from the UWA Business School in conjunction with another faculty at UWA.

Upon completion of the program, graduates are recognised throughout the world as capable, qualified individuals who can contribute to the success of their organisations and are capable of progressing rapidly within their careers. The knowledge and skills developed in the undergraduate degree programs will prepare students to become business leaders, whether it be in Australia or internationally.



Postgraduate

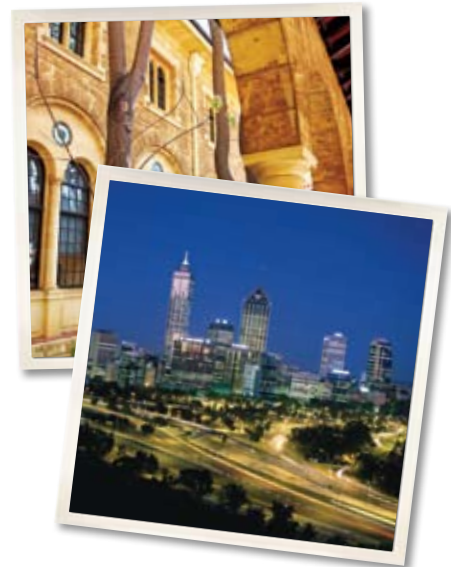

- Major centre for the booming energy and resources industry
- More than 25% of world's largest resources companies have regional headquarters in Perth, including BHP Billiton, Woodside, Rio Tinto, Chevron, and Shell to name a few
- Western Australia's economy recorded a higher rate of growth than China, far exceeding Australia's national growth rate (2006)
- Unemployment rate in Western Australia (March 2008) was a mere 3.3%, boasting the lowest unemployment level in all of Australia
